

Dereham Walkers are Welcome

Dumpling and Northall Greens walk

10:00, Friday 3 December 2021

Meet outside the Assembly Rooms.

The full walk is a little longer than some at a nearly $7\frac{1}{2}$ miles. As we have not been very far recently it may be shortened to $3\frac{1}{2}$ or $5\frac{1}{2}$ miles.

We will be heading south under the A47, and over the railway. A short route back to town presents itself at Yaxham Road ($3\frac{1}{2}$ miles). The full walk continues along Dumpling Green, then we turn north back over the A47 towards the windmill. Here there is a second opportunity to return to town ($5\frac{1}{2}$ miles). The walk continues to Northall Green, then back through the cemetery to the town centre.

There are two easy gates on the walk.

At this time, it is anticipated that there will be no Government restrictions related to COVID-19, but we would encourage you to continue to follow them for the safety and well being of all.

We therefore plan that

- the walk will be organised so that everyone normally keeps a distance of at least 2 metres from all other participants (except those in the same group);
- where this cannot be maintained (eg at pinch points and/or when passing other people), a lesser distance will be accepted for short periods; and
- we would like to have your phone number to pass on to NHS Test and Trace if necessary.

A full risk assessment will be completed.
