



Dereham Walkers are Welcome

Fens & Meadows Walk

Monday 28 May 2018



Join us for a 6½ miles walk, taking about 2¾ hours including 15 minutes for a short break, visiting some of the fens and meadows in and near the town. The walk starts from the car park for The George Hotel (Swaffham Road, Dereham NR19 2AZ; 01362 696801) at 1000. We can use their car park, but as we will be leaving cars for a long time, we need to park close together and as far out of the way of other customers as we can.

The route planned takes us out under the town sign and down the High Street, but soon leaves behind the shops to walk down Rolling Pin Lane along the edge of the water meadows. Then we'll come back to the allotments and the recently improved play area before crossing under the A47 and between houses. We will walk through Potter's Fen and along the edge of Scarning Fen before using some quiet lanes to reach a footpath taking us back across the A47. We will then make our way through Rush Meadow, finally returning to the start (and drinks and cake) past St Nicholas Church. *Please note that the route may be changed if conditions necessitate this.*

There are just a couple of gates and stiles on the walk. Well controlled dogs are welcome - there are a few open spaces but we do cross a number of roads, including the A47. *Please note that there are no toilets on the route, nor do we pass any shops or food or drink outlets of any sort until we are back at the start.*
