



Dereham Walkers are Welcome New Routes Walk

10:00, Monday 27 August 2018



Join us for a 6½ mile walk, taking about 2¾ hours, visiting the 'new routes' being established in the town. The walk starts at 1000 from Dereham Windmill (Greenfields Road, Dereham NR20 3TE; <http://www.derehamwindmill.co.uk/>). If coming by car, please approach along Greenfields Road not Cherry Lane - we can use their car park, or park on Greenfields Road. If coming by bus, First Bus XL and Konect bus 8 have stops in both directions on Norwich Road near the top of Cherry Lane. The Windmill has kindly arranged access to the café toilets at the start of the walk.

The walk itself will explore all of the routes which have been claimed by Dereham Town Council as public rights of way; all of them are being recognised as Restricted Byways. (We will also use one additional route which is to be dedicated as a bridleway.) And we will take the opportunity (postponed from a very wet Easter) to call in briefly at Badley Moor Common.

The walk is about 6½ miles long, taking about 2¾ hours. *Please note that the route may be changed if conditions necessitate this.*

There are no gates or stiles on the walk, apart from a kissing gate giving entry to Badley Moor. Well controlled dogs are welcome - half of the route is along isolated tracks, but we do also use and cross a number of roads. *Please note that after the first half hour, there are no toilets on the route, nor do we pass any shops or food or drink outlets of any sort until we are back at the start.*
