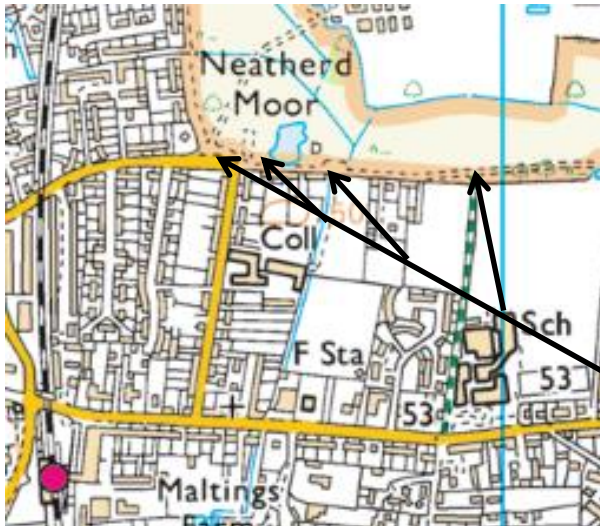




Dereham Walkers are Welcome

A *Hogmanay Hike* - but no, it won't be a route march, just a good way of clearing your head of any leftover 2018 cobwebs, and getting yourself ready to honour all those New Year Resolutions.

The walk will explore the land to the east of Dereham, mainly south of the A47 in the Tud Valley.

We will start at 10:00 from the parking areas at The Neatherd: parking is available just off the corner of the road, or at 3 further places down the road/track running east.

The walk is about 6½ miles, taking about 2½ hours, and will include a short break half way round.

There are no gates or stiles on the walk. Well controlled dogs are welcome on the walk, though open spaces are limited and we do cross and walk along a number of roads. *Please note that there are no toilets or any food and drink outlets at any point on the walk (including the start point).* On return, we make our way (5-10 minutes) to a nearby house, where tea or coffee plus seasonal food will be waiting.
